CFR/EQR Requirements for States - Mandatory Activities

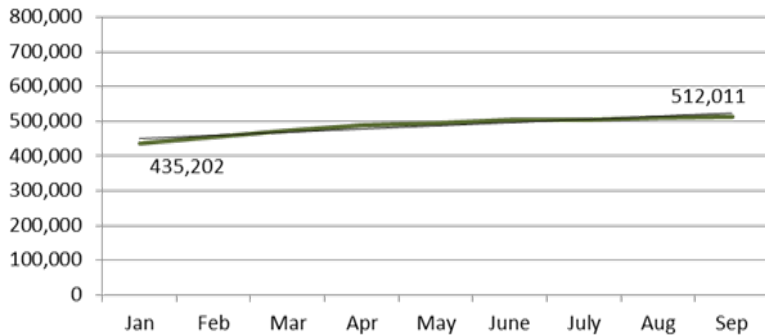
- Review of MCOs conducted by an external quality review organization (annual EQR report)
- Structured monitoring of MCOs (HCA)
- Annual validation of MCO clinical and non-clinical performance improvement projects (PIP) (HCA)
- Annual validation of MCO performance measures (aka HEDIS audit by EQRO)

CFR Requirements for States - Optional Activities

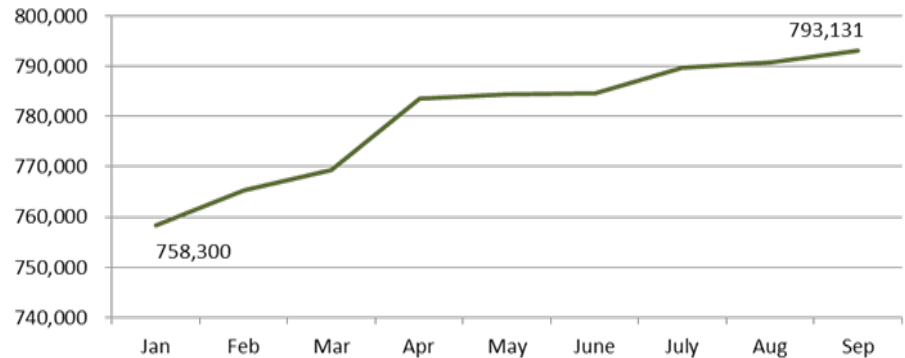
- Validate MCO encounter data

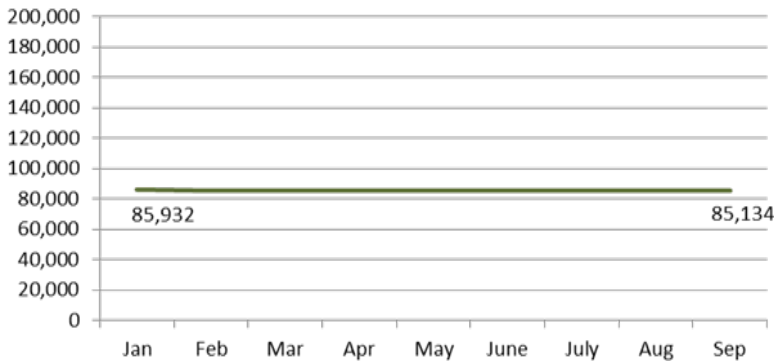
Apple Health Adult Coverage (AHAC)



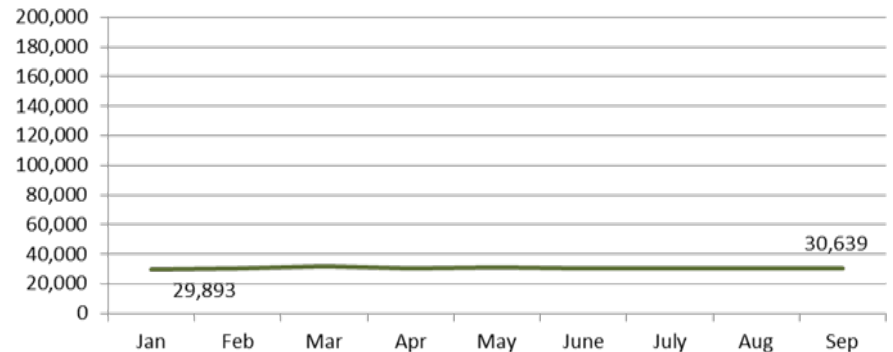
Apple Health Family (AHF)



Apple Health Blind and Disabled (AHBD)



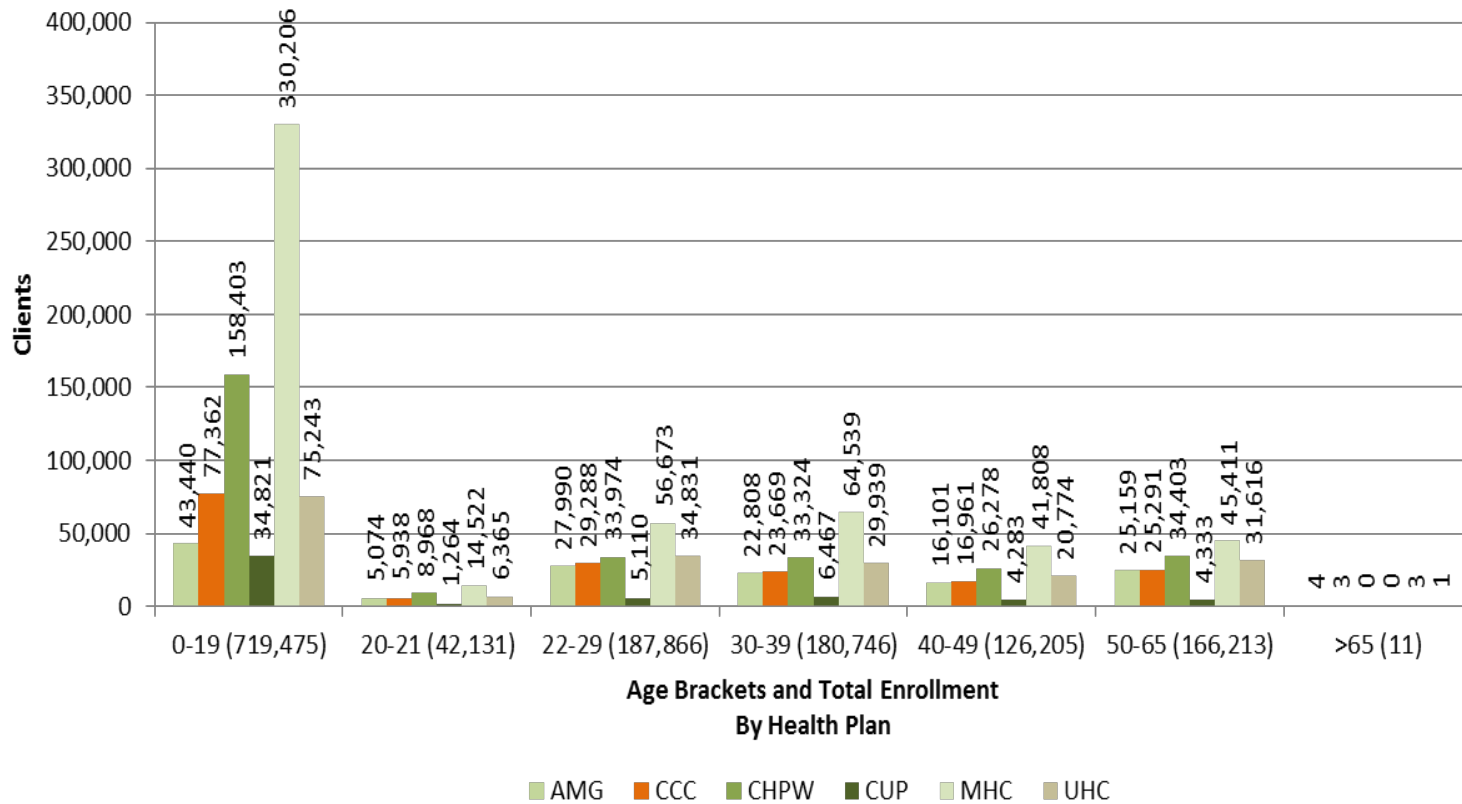

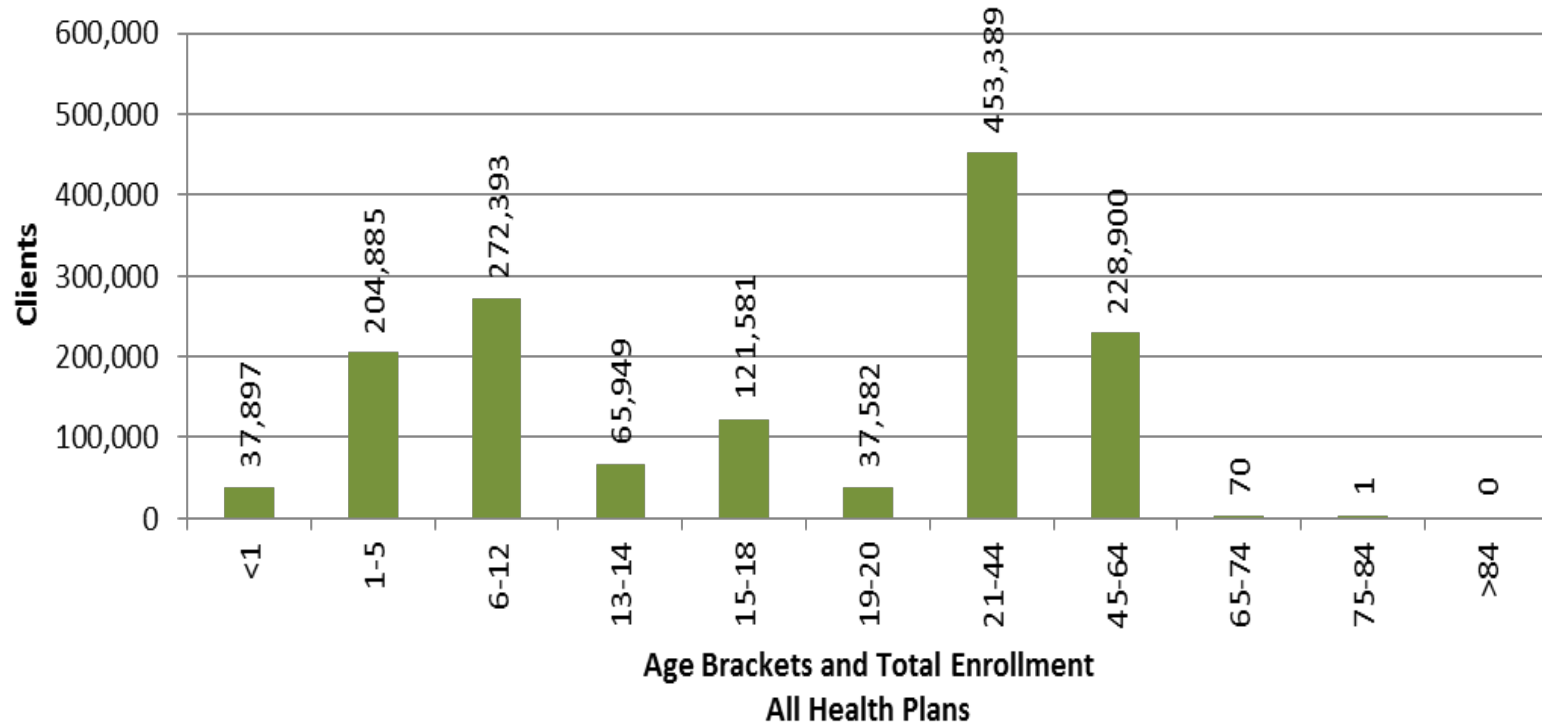

Enrollment by Age by Plan



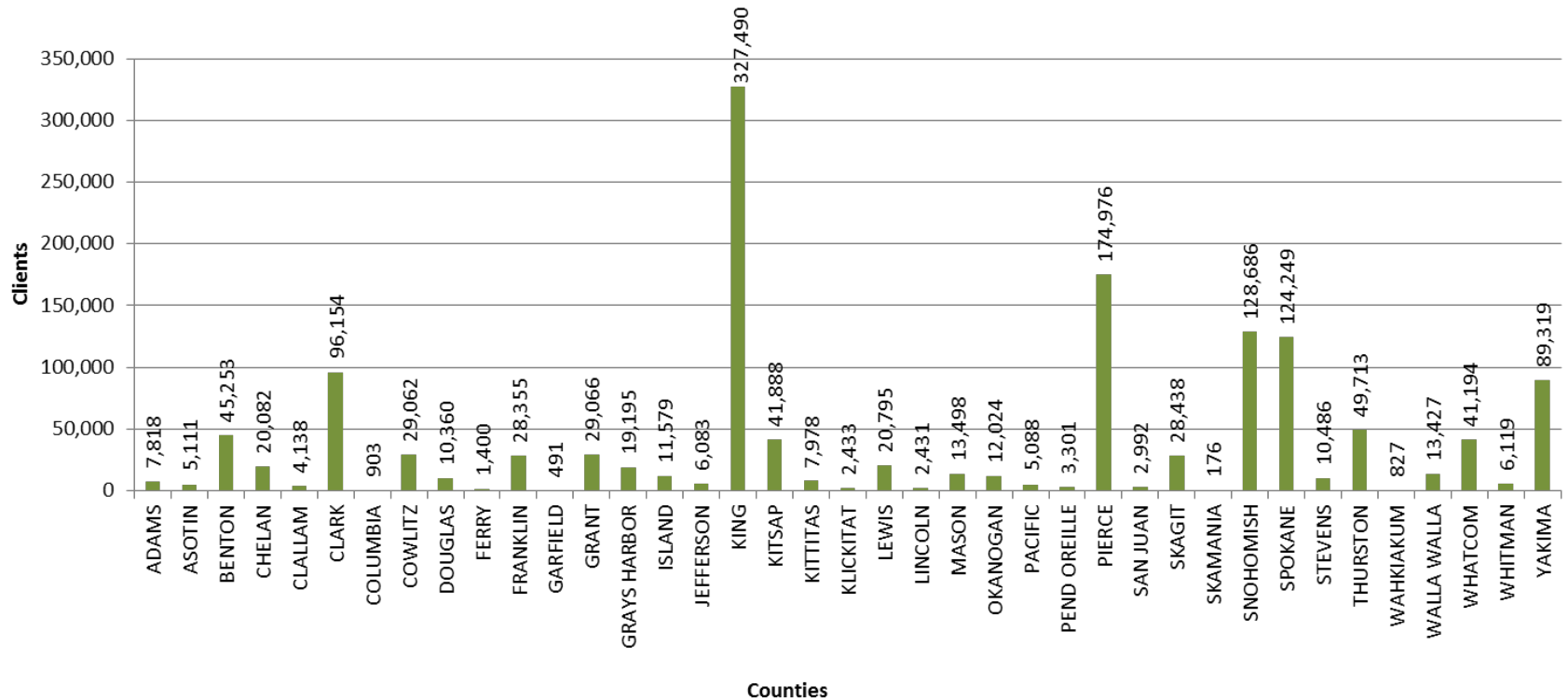

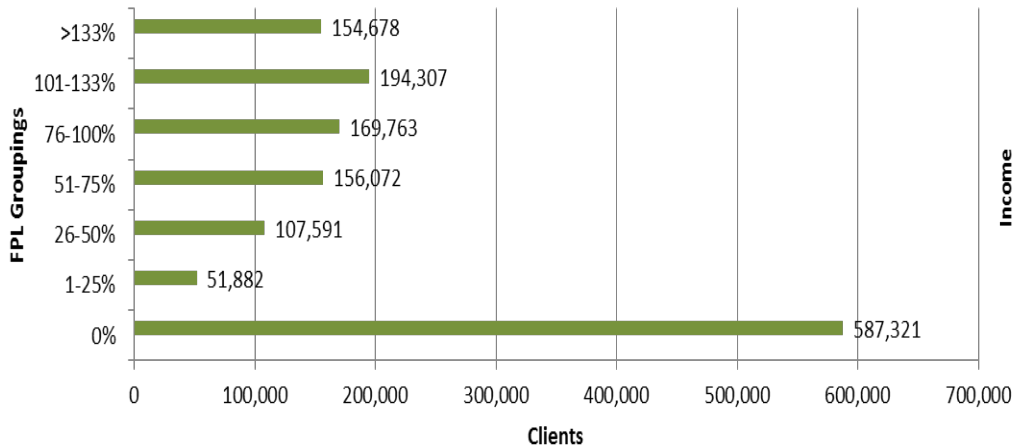

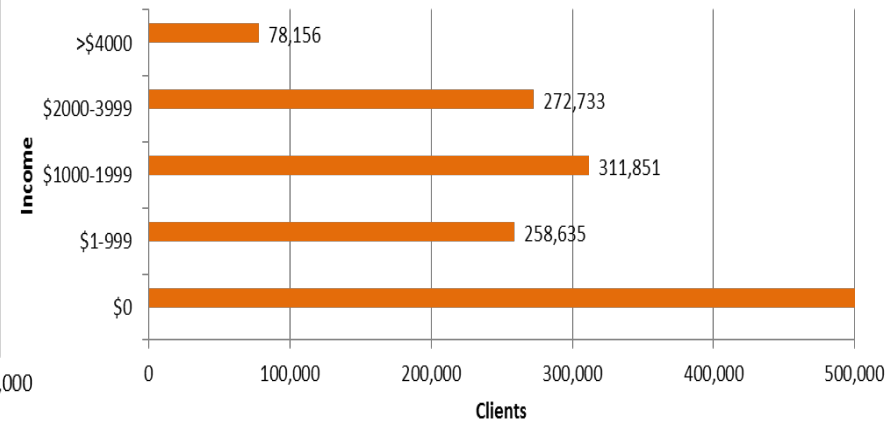


Enrollment by: Federal Poverty Level and Income

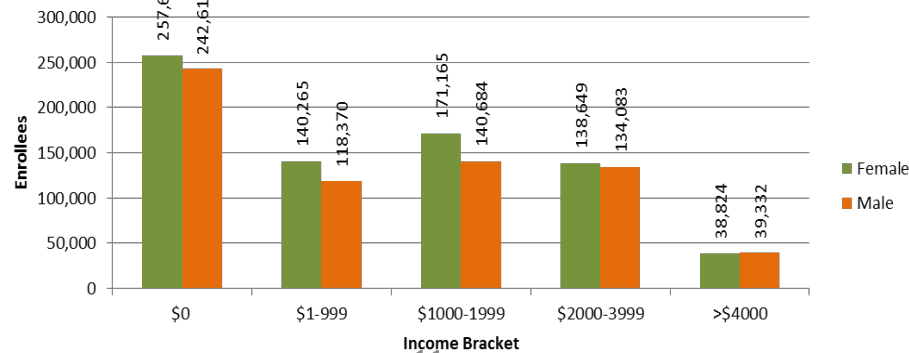
Client FPL Groupings



Monthly Income Bracket Groupings

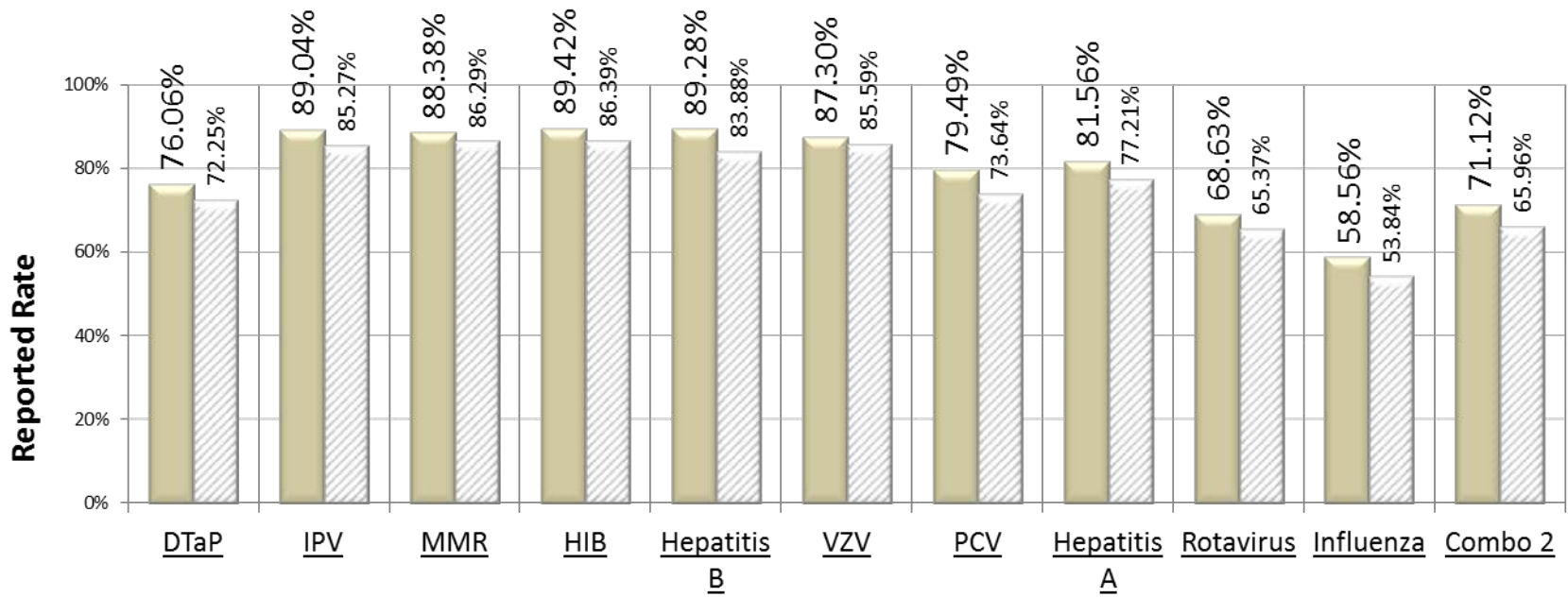


Monthly Income Bracket (Based on Gender)

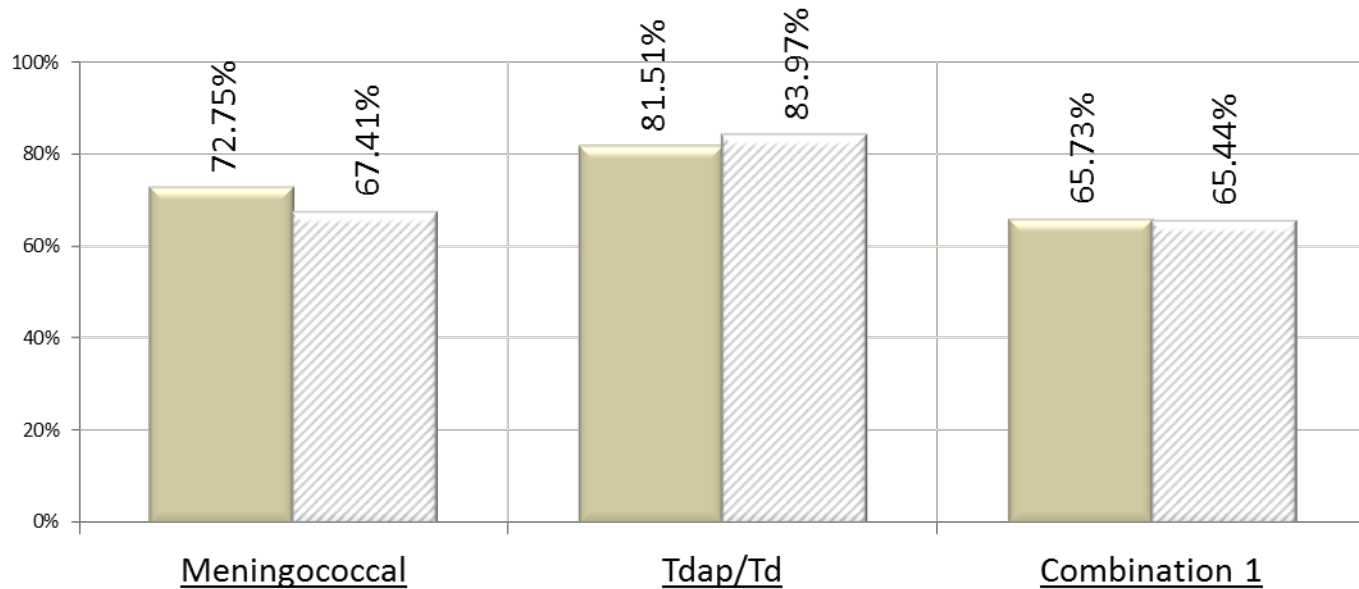

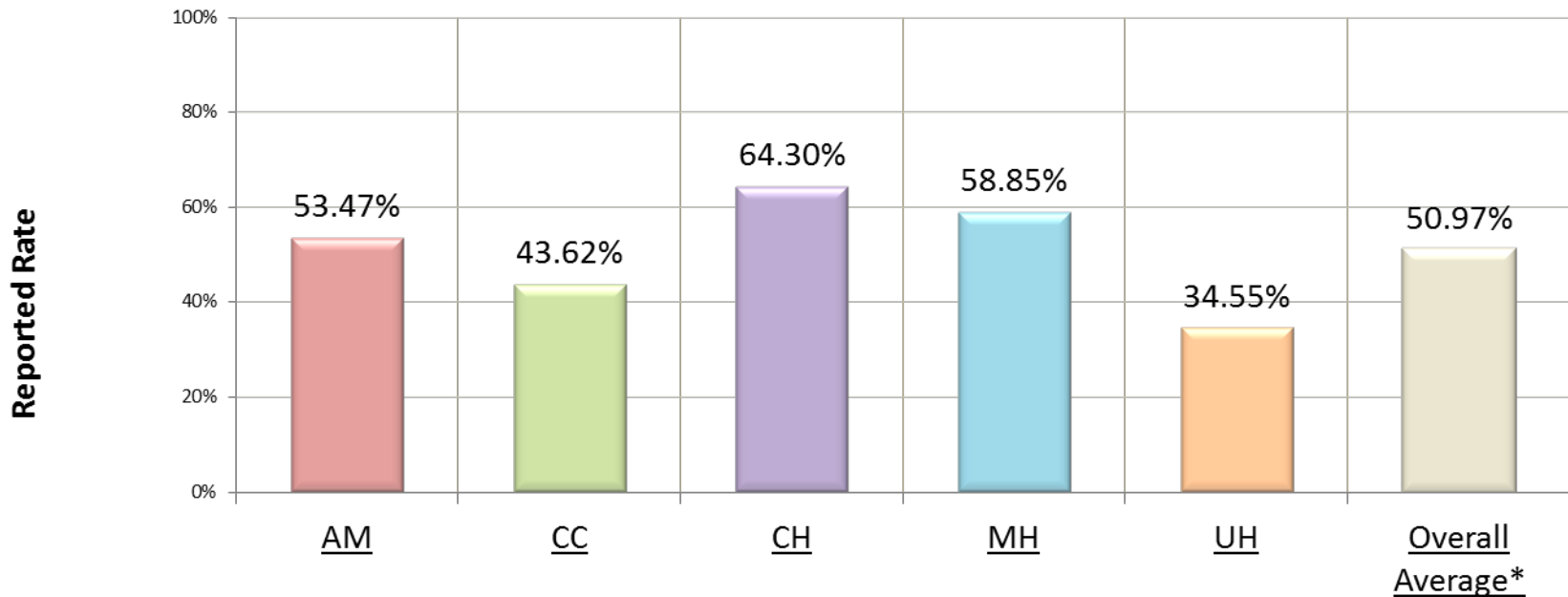
Adolescent Immunizations

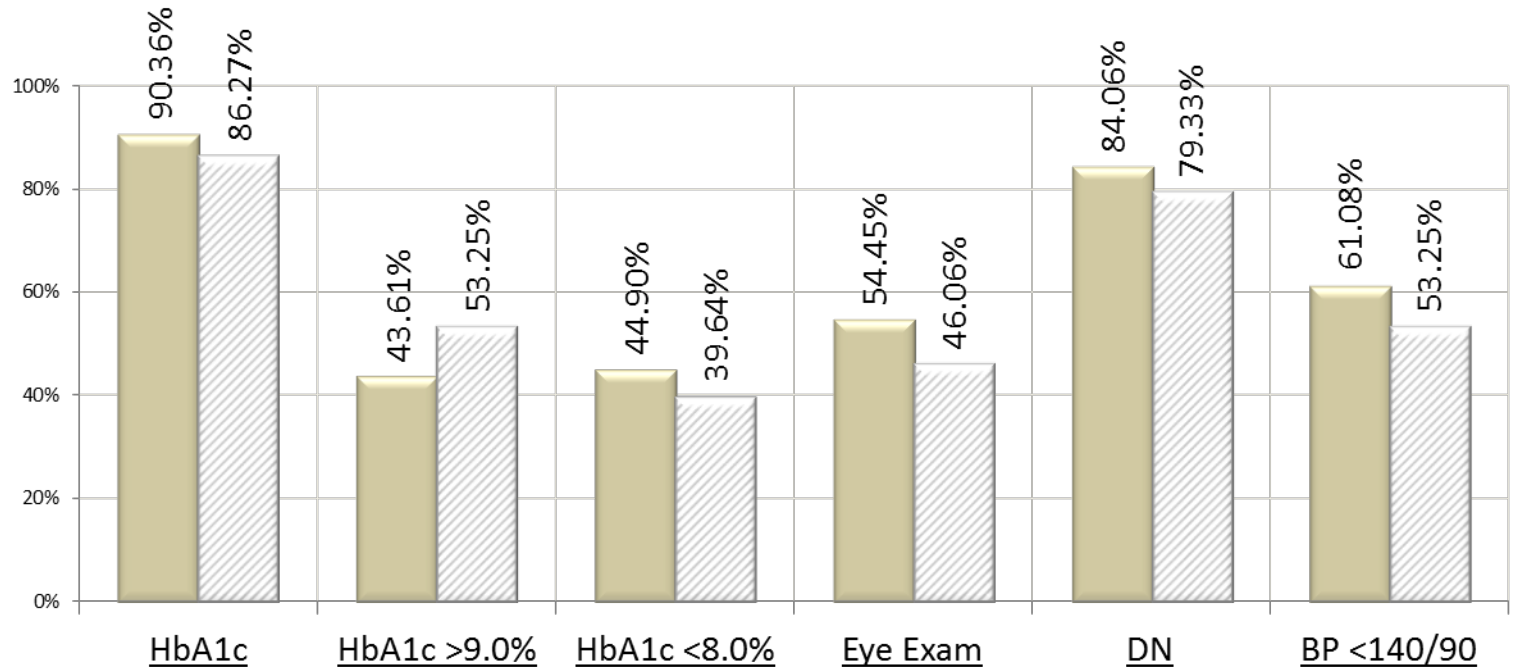
Controlling High Blood Pressure

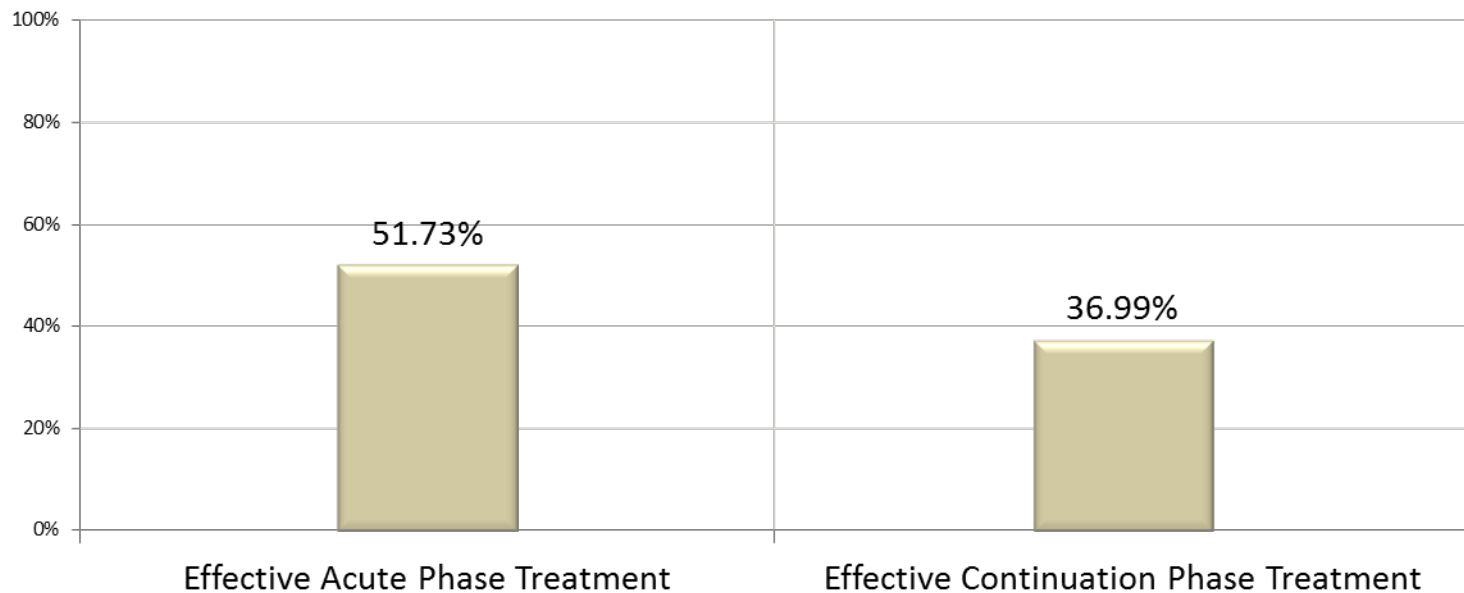

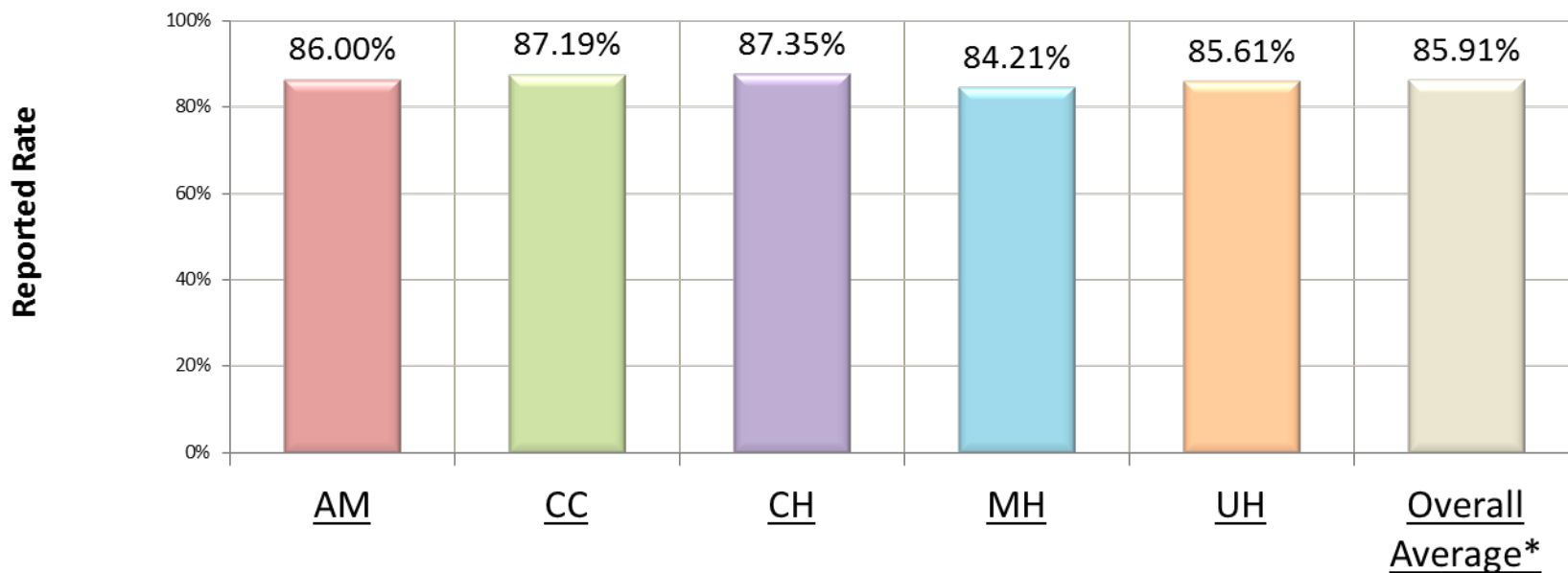

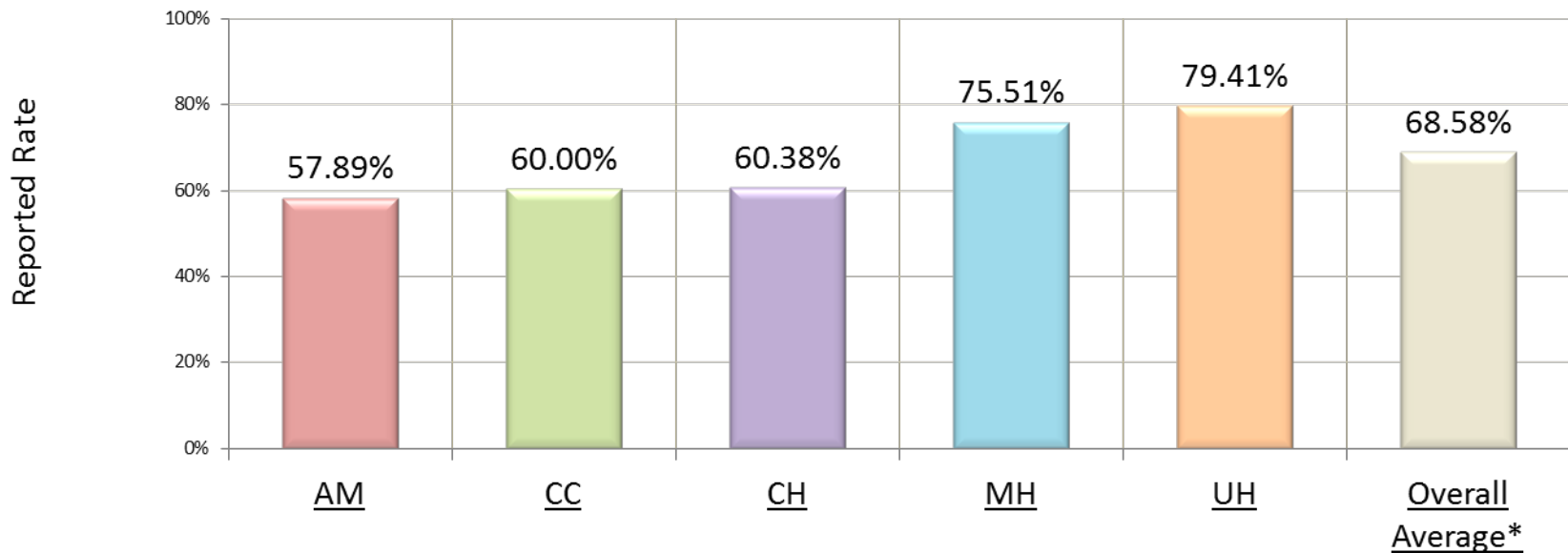

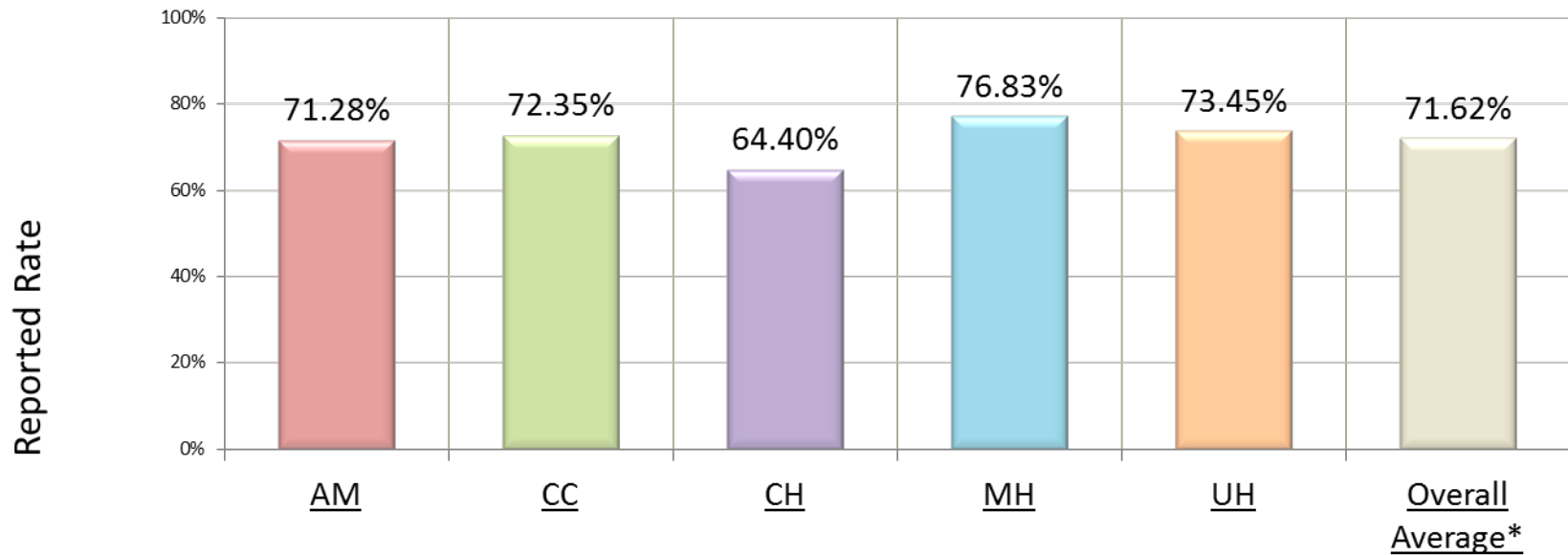

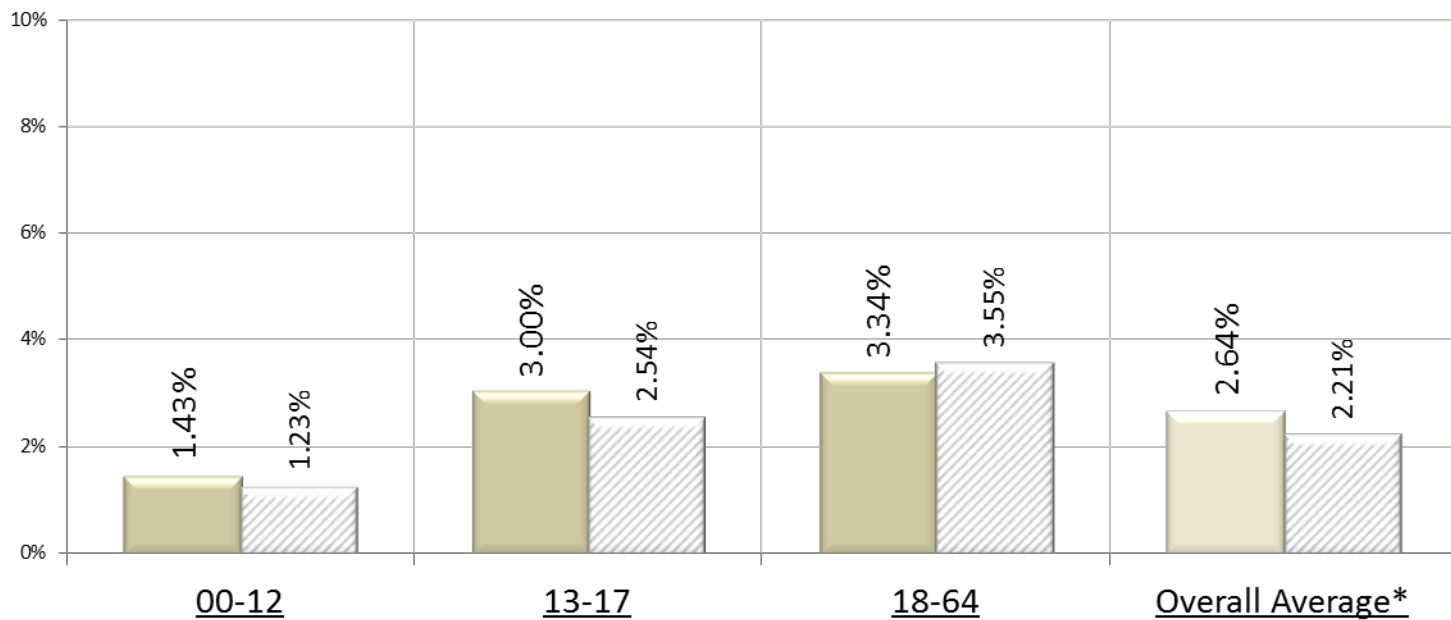
Adherence to Antipsychotic Medications for Individuals With Schizophrenia

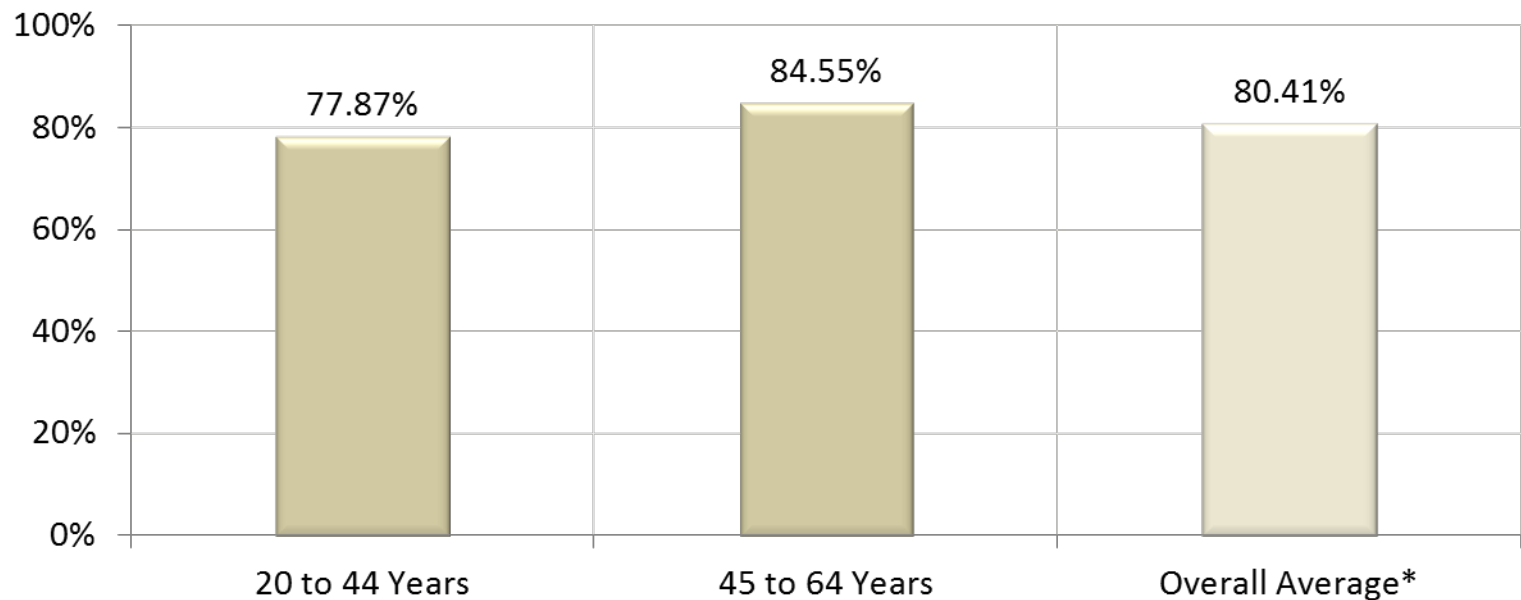
Mental Health Utilization – Outpatient and ED - Total

Outpatient/ED Total



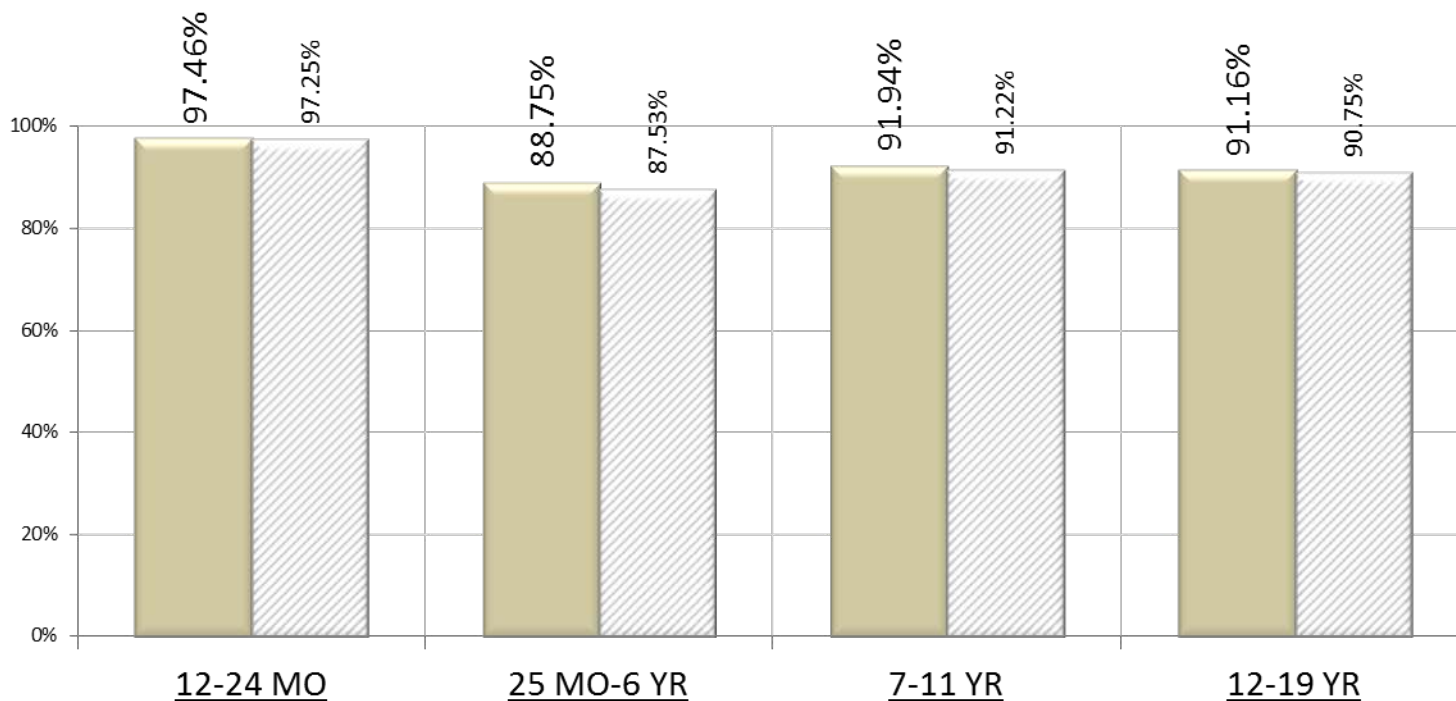
Adults Access to Ambulatory Care Services

2015 NCQA Overall Average



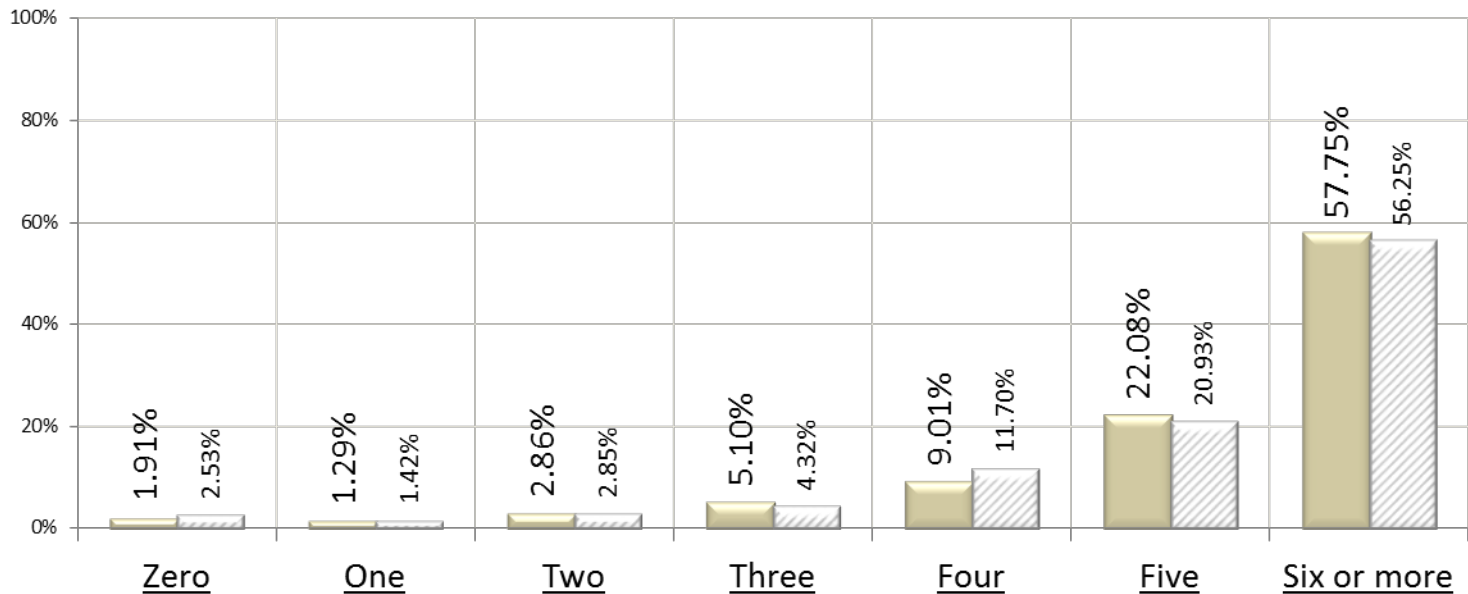
Children and Adolescents Access to Primary Care Services

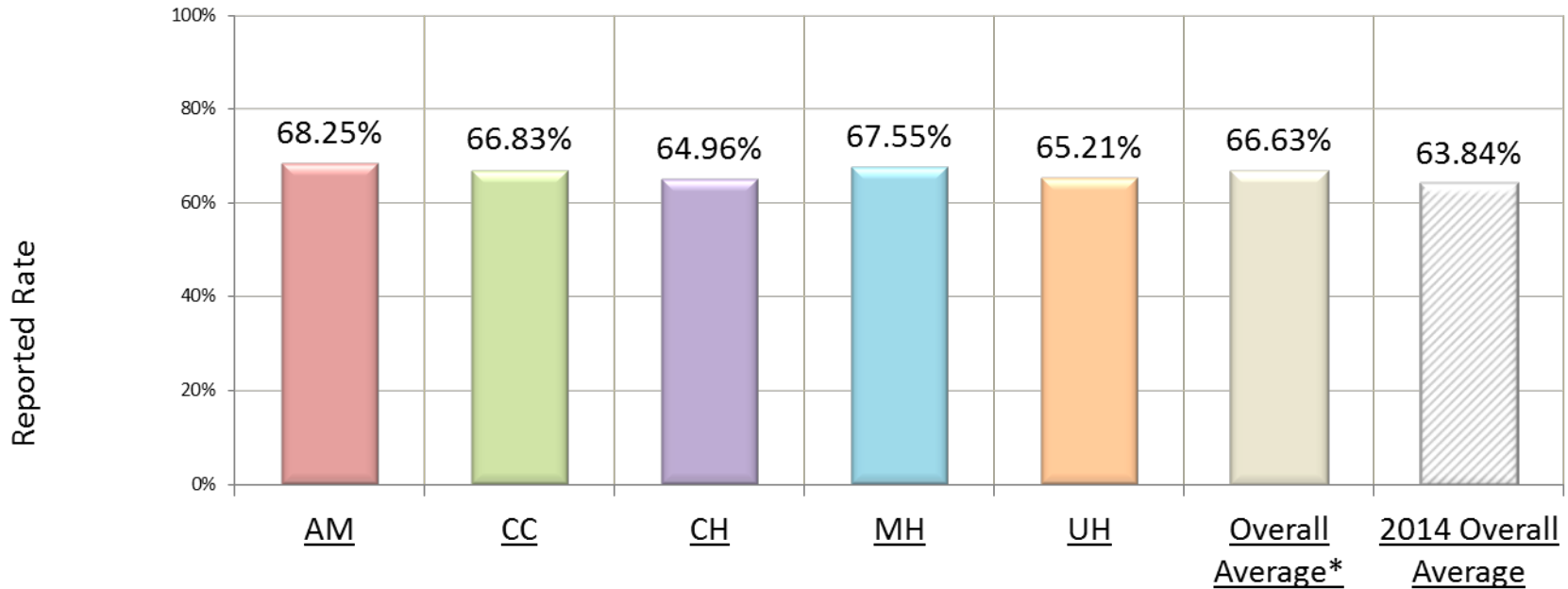

Well-Child Visits: Third, Fourth, Fifth and Sixth Years of Life

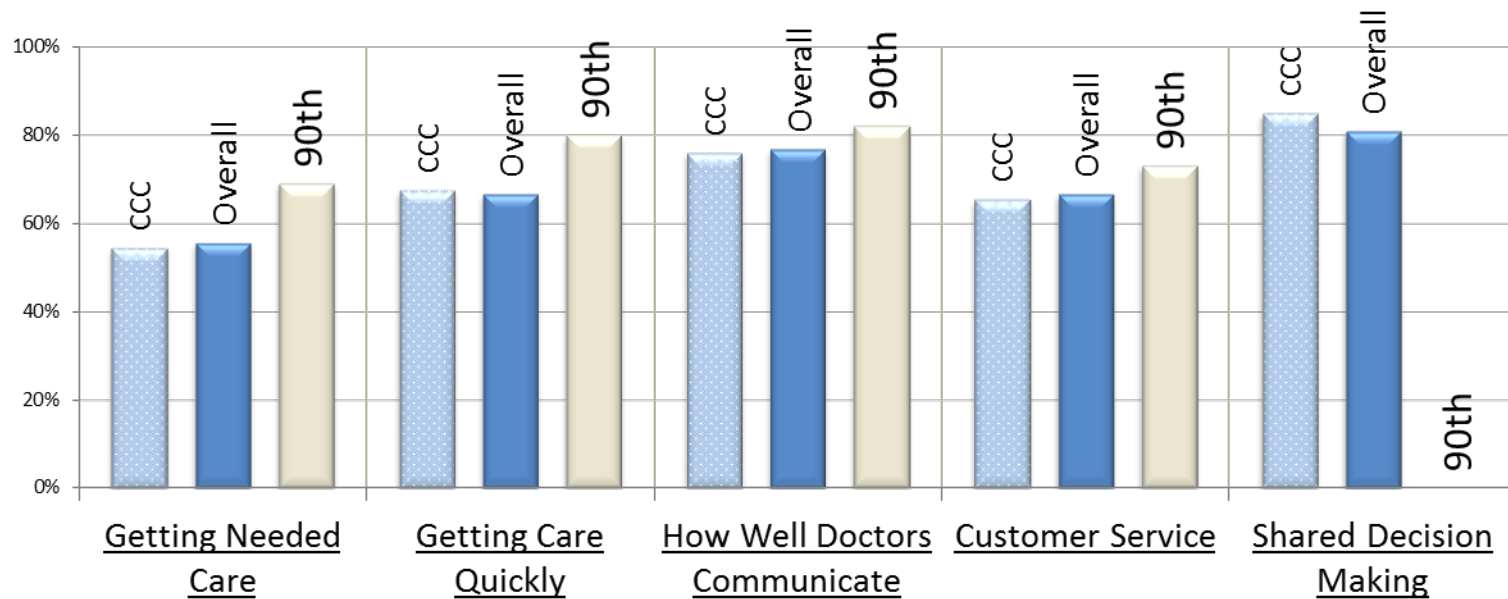

CAHPS – Child and Child with Chronic Conditions Survey

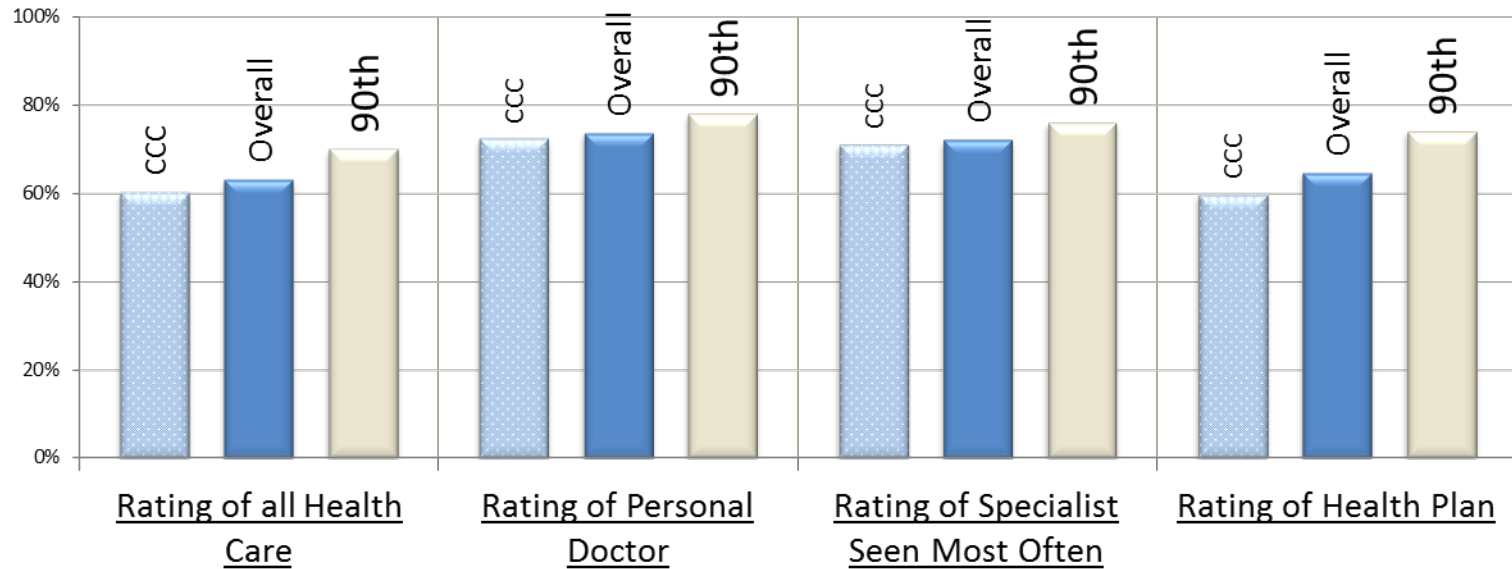
Standard Composites - 2015 CAHPS

Medication Assisted Treatment

- 2015 Legislature – HCA budget request
- August-September – MCO training
- October 1 – Go live
- October – November – Weekly meetings

Medication Assisted Treatment

- Allows use of buprenorphine/naloxone as a opioid substitute for substance use disorder
- Prescribers:
 - Prior auth. - Dose > than 24 mgm. per day
 - Must complete MAT Patient Status Form every 6 months
 - At induction – 7 day supply
 - Urine drug screens during first month of Rx

Medication Assisted Treatment

- Clients may remain on MAT ongoing
- Length of treatment determined by provider/client
- Medical records may be reviewed for compliance with agency policy
